

OCCUPATIONAL RISK ASSESSMENT

Have you been informed about the occupational risk assessment for your workplace?



According to Article 226 of the Labour Code, the employer is obliged to assess and document occupational risks and to inform employees about them.

Your supervisor should familiarise you with the occupational risk assessment (Ocena ryzyka zawodowego, ORZ) at your workplace.



The purpose of a risk assessment is to ensure that you are effectively protected against the hazards present in your working environment.



The assessment makes it possible to identify work-related hazards that can cause accidents at work, occupational diseases and other health complaints.

The resulting recommendations and proposed improvements from the risk assessment should be implemented.



Familiarisation with the occupational risk assessment (ORZ) must be confirmed in writing.

Remember! Occupational risks are only acceptable when they have been assessed as low or medium.
